

Hotel Suggestions – AAC in the Desert Conference/ Draft 1-05-15

Note: I have spent a great deal of time trying to select hotels. I visited each of the hotels listed below. I also visited several others that I removed from the list of possible hotels. IMPORTANT – some of the inexpensive hotels listed as ‘near the airport’ will NOT be in safe zones. I have tried to list information of interest to attendees. I requested ‘deals’ from hotels, but found that deals offered on websites were actually better. Here is my recommendation:

- 1) Pick a hotel that seems to meet your needs
- 2) Look at TripAdvisor and the hotel website to find out more info about the one(s) you like
- 3) Go to a search engine that offers hotel discounts. Be SURE you are getting the ones I suggested (ex: there are several Comfort Suites – the one with address below is the only one I have visited). Sample bargain hotel websites are:
