What:

Clam Shell Mounting Bracket:

This heavy-gauge steel bracket (2.5" x 2.5") is designed for mounting communications equipment in a vehicle. We've found them excellent for mounting a switch or a small device (ex: Stepby-Step from Able Net). The angle of the bracket is easily adjusted by loosening /tightening a small thumb screw. Once a useful angle has been established, Lock Tight can be added to keep the angle secure. As you can see, holes are pre-drilled in both top and bottom plates. Mounting screws are included.

Who:

The Clam Shell Mounting Bracket can help students who need to have switches or very small devices securely mounted. For example: Sallie uses a switch with her right hand. When the switch was flat on her laptray, it was difficult for her to access, as she had to lift her hand to pull off the switch. Having the switch mounted helped her as she could use gravity to release her hand from the switch.

Paula's best movement is a lateral movement of her left hand. Her Step-by-Step was mounted so that the surface was vertical. That allowed her to use her hand to press and release.

How:

Use the holes provided to mount the bracket permanently, or use Velcro[©] or Dual Lock Velcro[©] to mount it securely but less permanently.
